# Leader's Guide:

## Praise God, from Whom All Blessings Flow



"The Doxology" is a great hymn to bond young and old together in intergenerational worship. As children learn that "doxology" means "glory," help them understand that their lives should be a "doxology" that brings glory to God.

### ● SIMPLIFIED PIANO ARRANGEMENT

This arrangement may be assigned to a young piano student.

### ● THOMAS KEN'S FAMOUS HYMN

Emphasize how Thomas Ken wrote this hymn for young people to use in their private worship. Remind children that hymns are valuable tools for private and corporate worship.

### ● FUN PAGES FOR SINGERS

Use these pages:

- With children who arrive early
- In a small learning group
- As a take-home page.

If a page is sent home, suggest that parents and children work on the puzzle together.

### ● "PRAISE GOD, FROM WHOM ALL BLESSINGS FLOW" DRAMATIC HYMN INTRODUCTION

Combine musical and dramatic creativity in this introduction. Use bells, keyboard, or a solo instrumentalist to play the melody phrases as the reader presents each scripture.

Praise God, from whom all blessings flow;

Praise Him, all creatures here below;

Praise Him above, ye heav'nly host;

Praise Father, Son, and Holy Ghost

Amen.
